If they take a bus when they arrive to school, they will go to their first period teachers' room, to be monitored and watched by their 1st period teacher. There is NOT a holding room since 1st period teachers are giving their own exams and ARE available to supervise them! (For example, if a student who is exempted from 1st Block and needs to take their 2nd Period Exam, the student shows up to your 1st period, then they stay with you in class during that time!)</p>	<p>a student does not have a fourth period exam, BUT is a bus rider, they should be sent to their fourth period teachers' room, to be monitored and watched. There is NOT a holding room since 4th period teachers are giving their own exams and ARE available to supervise them! (For example, if a student who is exempted shows up to your period, then they stay with you in class!) !</p> <p>Students who only have a 4th period exam must be on campus at 9:30am. If they take a bus when they arrive at school, they will go to their third period teachers' room, to be monitored and watched by their 3rd period teacher. There is NOT a holding room since 3rd period teachers are giving their own exams and ARE available to supervise them! (For example, if a student who is exempted from the 3rd Period Exam and needs to take their 4th Period Exam, the student shows up to your 3rd period, then they stay with you in class during that time!)</p>
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### **Schedule Information:**

- All administrations of post assessments must be in person as required by state policy. **Students may not take these exams from home.** Students in Virtual Academy must communicate with their teacher the exam schedule for courses that do not have a state exam.
- Students should bring their WCPSS Chromebooks and charger with them to their testing site. The device must be fully charged and prepared for testing.
- Students will be allowed to leave campus after the testing session if they have an exit ticket -
- Students who ride the bus will remain on campus until noon, even if they do not have an exam
- Students must remain in their assigned rooms for the duration of the exam block. The earliest dismissal (with a signed permission slip) being 9:30am if the entire room is done.

- **Make up testing:** If you miss your exam you must communicate with your instructor on when to make up your missed exam.
- **CTE courses include:** Animal Science II (Small Animal), Career Management, Child Development, Financial Planning I (Field Test), Financial Planning II (Field Test), Food and Nutrition I, · Food and Nutrition II -ANSI, Tier 2, · Foundations of Health Science, · Health Science I (Field Test), Horticulture II, Interior Design Fundamentals, Marketing Applications, Principles of Business and Finance, Principles of Family and Human Services, Project Management I, Sports and Entertainment Marketing II
- **CTE Students Taking Courses @ Other Schools:: Testing on Jan 13th:** Accounting I Honors, Child Development, Health Science I, Interior Design Fundamentals, Principles of Business and Finance, Sports and Entertainment Marketing I
- **EOC courses include:** English 2, Math 1, Biology, Math 3 (NCVPS in these subjects included)
- **EOC Testing Times**
  - **Biology:** estimated 120 mins with a maximum testing time of 180 mins (without accommodations)
  - **English 2:** estimated 150 mins with a maximum testing time of 240 mins (without accommodations)
  - **Math 1:** estimated 180 mins with a maximum testing time of 240 mins (without accommodations)
  - **Math 3:** estimated 180 mins with a maximum testing time of 240 mins (without accommodations)

\*Students may use the maximum number of minutes for testing if needed

\* Students with accommodations will be given their extended time

## Exam Exemptions

Students in Grades 9-12 at Rolesville High School may be eligible for teacher made exam exemptions based on specific criteria outlined below. This policy aims to recognize students' consistent academic performance and attendance throughout the semester.

- Eligibility Criteria
- Grade Requirement:
- Students must have a projected final grade of B or higher in the course.
- Students can have no more than 10 absences and also no more than 10 tardies and must have a course grade of a 80% or higher to be exempt from teacher-made exams.

## Attendance Requirement:

Students must have 10 or fewer absences in the course.

All absences, excused or unexcused, are counted equally toward the 10-day limit.

College visitations are included in the 10-day absence count.

**State Testing:**

Students cannot be exempt from state-mandated tests (EOC Exam & CTE Post-Assessments), including field testing.

**Principal's Authority:**

The principal, consistent with GS 115C-288, has the final authority to determine a student's exemption status.

**\*\*\*Teachers must communicate with all students on Wednesday January 14th, 2026 if the student is exempt or not. (this is a hard date). Exemption grade status is based on the students' Projected F1 Grade.**

**A.) If students have not reached exemption status by January 14th, 2026, they will not be exempt from their exams.**

**B) Once a teacher has informed a student they have reached exemption status on January 14th, 2026 it cannot be CHANGED.**

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
