

EOG & EOC Testing Information!!!

Please review the following important information regarding End-of-Grade (EOG) testing. After reviewing, please respond to confirm that you have received and understand this information.

Connections Academy will administer EOG testing for 6th and 7th grade students from May 29 through June 2, 2026. Students will not test every day.

Testing Schedules

Families should have received an email or text message through Infinite Campus with their child's individual testing schedule. Sixth and seventh-grade students will each have two testing days.

Attendance Expectations

Students are only required to attend school on their assigned testing days. If students are not scheduled to test on a specific day, their absences will be excused.

Students Who Attend on Non-Testing Days

Because EOG testing will be taking place throughout the building from May 29–June 11, students who come to school without needing to test or make up an EOG will:

- Be placed in a separate room
- Follow a different schedule from peers
- Not have access to computers, as devices will be secured during testing
- Be expected to remain quiet until noon to support the testing environment

Connections Academy Middle School Testing Dates

6th & 7th Grade

- **May 29:** Reading & Math EOG Testing for selected 6th & 7th grade students
- **June 1:** Math EOG Testing for selected students
- **June 2:** Reading EOG Testing for selected students

8th Grade Only

- **May 28:** Math 1 EOC Testing

- **June 3:** Science EOG Testing for 8th grade students only
No 6th or 7th grade students should report to the building on this day. Their absences will be excused.

Make-Up Testing & Retesting

- **June 4:** Make-up testing & retesting only
- **June 5:** Make-up testing & retesting until 11:15 AM
A student recognition ceremony will be held later that afternoon. Additional information will be shared soon.

Off-Campus & Online Students

Students participating in off-campus or online instruction will complete EOG testing from **June 7–11**. Only students scheduled for testing should report to the building during this time. All other students will receive excused absences.

Transportation & Early Pick-Up

Once students finish testing for the day, they may call home for early pick-up if desired. School buses will continue operating on their regular schedules throughout EOG testing.

Summer Reminder

After students complete all required testing, they will have fulfilled all requirements for the 2025–2026 school year.
