Homework

The following are school-wide expectations for homework:

- Homework will count as no more than 10% of the overall grade for each quarter.
- Homework will be closely aligned to standards and objectives.
- Students have opportunities to earn partial credit for late homework.
- At risk students will be given additional classroom support with homework.

Classwork & Assessments

The following are school-wide expectations for classwork and assessments:

- Incomplete classwork can be homework.
- Students will utilize class time and participate in discussions about assignments and expectations.

Missing Work and Work Not Submitted

The following are school-wide expectations for missed work:

- Late work/work not submitted may be turned in for partial credit prior to the final week of the quarter.
- Work that has not been submitted will be reflected as a ZERO in Infinite Campus so that parents have an accurate understanding of a student's academic progress. If the work remains missing at end of quarter, the teacher will change it to a 49 to align with policy 3400.
- If the absence is approved in advance all make-up work, including tests assigned for the day of return, is due upon the student's return to school. Teachers should use discretion and may make exceptions in the case of students whose excused absences were not planned in advance, were

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beyond the student's control, and the nature of which would not support make-up work the day of return

Extra Credit

Extra credit is offered at the PLC's discretion. Where it is offered, extra credit opportunities to enhance grades must be connected to learning outcomes and consistent within PLCs.
