

Wake Tech's Career & College Promise (CCP) program offers eligible high school students the opportunity to earn credits toward a college degree or a credential for employment – tuition-free (there is sometimes a fee for textbooks.) In many cases, students earn dual credit, meeting high school graduation requirements with college courses.

Starting Points to Apply for the CCP Program-READ THIS INFORMATION!

- **SUPER IMPORTANT!!!** Juniors and Seniors must have an unweighted GPA of at least a 2.8 to apply for College Transfer Classes. Freshmen and Sophomores have move stringent requirements, to take a College Transfer class.
- Enrollment requirements for CTE Classes are different for all students.

- Students will need a recent copy of their transcript for CCP. To request a transcript, email Mr. Greene, egreene@wcpss.net from your school email.
- When completing the application, ALL students should list Mr. Greene, <u>egreene@wcpss.net</u>, as the principal/designee on the Wake Tech forms.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who helps me schedule my CCP Classes?

Staff in the CCP Program at Wake Tech will assist you with scheduling your CCP classes after you have completed the enrollment process. Your LRHS Counselro cannot assist you with this process.

Do CCP Classes go on my Leesville Transcript?

Yes, all classes you take through CCP will appear on your Leesville Transcript and calculate into your GPA.

How are course weighted in dual enrollment?

<u>College Transfer Pathway</u> – The College Transfer classes carry an additional 1.0 credit weight on your GPA. All courses taken will be added to your transcript.

<u>Career and Technical Education Pathway –</u> Most of these classes do not carry weighted GPA points unless they are college transfer level. All courses taken will be added to your LRHS transcript.

What happens if I drop my CCP Class?

You must first drop the class with Wake Tech and then inform Mr. Greene asap! If you do not, you may incur an F on your Leesville transcript for the dropped class.
