Final Exam Schedule for 2025-2026

Final exams are required in all courses and will count for 20% of the grade in the course. Students can be exempt from teacher made exams, but not from EOCs or CTE State Assessments.

Note the Eligibility Criteria for Exam Exemption: All Criteria Must Be Met!

- A projected final grade of **B (80) or higher** in the course
- 10 or fewer absences in the course
 - o Excused and unexcused absences count equally, including college visits
- For grades 9–11, **10 or fewer tardies** in the course
- Students cannot be exempt from state-mandated assessments (EOCs, CTE Post-Assessments, or field tests)
- Students who meet the exemption criteria and have the potential to increase their overall letter grade may opt to take the final exam. In this case, the exam will count for 20% of the grade in the course only if the overall grade is improved.

EOCs and CTE State Assessments (see the list of courses below) will be administered in person using a WCPSS issued Chromebook to access the online exam. All other courses will have a teacher made exam or a final project. All EOC, CTE State assessments, and teacher made exams are required to be administered in person during the last 5 days of each semester.

For your convenience, the plans for exam days at Leesville Road High School are listed below. These plans are subject to change due to weather or other unanticipated events. Please do not make plans for the week of exams as we do not have flexibility to test outside of the 5-day testing window. A more detailed schedule will be published closer to the exam window.
