Dear Parent/Guardian:

I hope the school year is off to a successful start for you and your child. I am writing this letter to let you know that River Bend has been designated as a Targeted Support & Improvement Additional Targeted Support (TSI-AT) school by the North Carolina State Board of Education. Per ESSA Section 1111(d)(2), schools are identified as TSI-AT schools in North Carolina because one or more of the following subgroups received a subgroup performance grade score at or below the highest identified CSI-LP school's All Students group during the identification year; and is on the TSI-CU list for the subgroup(s) for the previous year. Subgroup performance scores are provided for the following subgroups: (1) Students with Disabilities, (2) Economically Disadvantaged, (3) Black, (4) White, (5) Hispanic, (6) Asian-Pacific Islander, (7) Multi-racial, and (8) English Learners. This letter is to notify our parents and guardians of River Bend ES intentions to improve educational outcomes for underperforming student subgroups and close achievement gaps for all students.

As a TSI-AT (ATSI) school, River Bend ES is required to develop an Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) plan that specifically addresses how the school will improve outcomes for underperforming subgroups. We have set the following goals for River Bend ES. this year:

- Increase reading growth for students with disability by 10points
- Increase math growth for all students with disabilities by 10 points

Our students need to experience higher achievement levels, but it will require hard work on the part of staff, students, and families. Here are some strategies River Bend ES. will be implementing:

 Teachers will discuss learning target focusing on key vocabulary words to ensure students understand unfamiliar words in relation to the skill/task

- Teachers teams will create smart goals and action plans based on quarterly data review.
- Classroom instructional practices will be monitored through administrative/leadership team walkthroughs
- Lesson plans will be reviewed by cabinet members (principal, AP, coaches and intervention team)
- All teachers will participate in Letrs training for literacy
- We will conduct literacy night, bilingual conference, math nights and All Pro-dads programs

Parent engagement is at the heart of our school improvement efforts. Here are some ways you can help:

- Make sure that both you and your student are aware of academic expectations set for your student this school year. A list of learning objectives in student-friendly language is available from your student's teacher(s).
- Call your child's teacher if you have questions or concerns about your student or to set up an appointment to meet with a school staff member who will be working with your student.
- Make sure that your student is prepared and attends school each day.
- Monitor your student's homework.
- Monitor the progress your student is making and attend meetings with your student's teacher(s).
