EXAM NOTES

- If a student does not have an exam during the scheduled time, the student will not report to school for that exam block. If a student is a bus rider with no other transportation option, they will report to their normal class for a study hall.
- Students are expected to take exams according to the schedule. Any deviation from the exam schedule requires prior approval. Requests must be made to Ms. Lumsden at shs-

testing@wcpss.net by December 19, 2024, for consideration. Requests for courses with state exams or CTE assessments will require supporting medical documentation. These requests are reviewed by NCDPI and are likely to be denied because of state testing procedures and regulations.

- Students may not check out of school during an exam period. This includes if the student finishes the exam early AND if the entire class finishes early. Students will only be dismissed at the end of the exam period.
- Students who do not have an EOC exam or a makeup exam do not attend school on January 13th, 14th, or 17th.
- If absent from an exam, the student is responsible for working with the teacher to schedule the make-up exam for a teacher-made exam. For an EOC or CTE Post Assessment, the teacher will tell you the date, time, and where to report.
- The State Testing and Accountability Program includes End of Course (EOC) exams, and post assessments for CTE.
- Seniors who meet the exemption requirements for teacher-made exams may be exempt from the final exam. Per Board Policy, seniors are not eligible for exemption from exams for courses with state testing requirements (EOC and CTE post assessments).
