Quick Steps for Rising 10th–12th Grade
Students



Overview

Recommendations:

- Enroll in maximum of 3 courses
- 10th graders in AIG must provide documentation for CCP Pathway courses
- Out-of-state AIG students may qualify for reciprocity
- 9th and 10th graders must submit [CCP Documentation Request Form](#)
- Request an official transcript via [Scribder](#) (select Career and College Promise)
- Summer session uses your Spring grade level

Step 1: Watch the Information Session

- PCHS counselors will not be able to advise on specific pathways.

Step 2: Research and Select Courses

- Choose CCP courses that align with your academic goals. Note: If PCHS offers an equivalent course, CCP forms may not be approved.

Step 3: Complete the CCP Application

Before starting:

- Review the New CCP Student Application User Manual.
- Use a personal email (e.g., Gmail).

Follow Wake Tech's new or continuing student instructions.

- Unless contacted by Ms. Telfair, submit the WCPSS enrollment and send the EV form.

Step 4: Dual Enrollment Form

- complete and submit a Dual Enrollment Form to Student Services for the courses you intend to register for. You may need to resubmit once officially registered.
- Courses may not be available when you finally register
- You must have a dual enrollment with us to receive credit.

Step 5: Eligibility Verification

- Provide the Principal Designee's email: stelfair@wcpss.net
- Follow your chosen college's directions and send transcripts via Scriborder.
- Unless contacted by Ms. Telfair, complete the WCPSS enrollment and EV form.
- 9th and 10th grade student need to complete the google form to request EOCs, AIG Documents and recommendation letters.
- Only submit once- you don't need to keep sending the request

Step 6: Acceptance Notification

- Students will receive an acceptance letter or email once documentation is reviewed and approved by the CCP Team.
- You can check the Wake Tech portal to ensure your documents have processed.

Step 7: Optional Early Release / Late Arrival

- 11th & 12th graders may apply for early release or late arrival while taking CCP classes. Athletes must maintain eligibility requirements (Take at least 3 courses)
- CCP class will count towards eligibility.

Step 8: Important Deadlines

- Spring: Submit by November 14, 2025
- Dual Enrollment Forms are **mandatory** for CCP courses to appear on transcripts.
- We will only allow 3 courses- if you do more we will only allow 3.
- Summer will be later and will be announced
