

Garner Magnet High School: Lunch Pass Application

Read carefully—incomplete applications will not be processed

*****Please write all information so that it can be read. Applications that cannot be read will not be accepted*****

I request that my son/daughter _____, be issued a lunch permit according to the conditions herein stated. I understand that failure to have the permit in his/her possession when leaving campus will, without question, result in disciplinary action as outlined below.

1. The lunch permit allows the student to leave campus during his/her regularly scheduled lunch period, provided he/she has the lunch permit card in possession at the time.
2. The student and parent primarily are responsible for where the student goes for lunch and for his/her transportation.
3. The school assumes no extra liability for any accident or injury incurred in the exercise of this permit. Provided policies are adhered to, school insurance will cover students as usual.
4. Students exercising off-campus lunch privileges are subject to the rules of student conduct, as applicable to the regular school day, and as adopted by the Wake County School Board and Garner Magnet High School.
5. A student with a lunch permit shall not associate himself with students without permits while off campus in the exercise of this lunch permit. Noncompliance will result in revocation of the permit and/or disciplinary action.
6. No food, drink, or litter is to be brought back on campus. Littering of public or private property may result in revocation of the permit and/or disciplinary action.
7. This lunch permit is subject to individual restrictions that may be deemed appropriate, and the general conditions herein contained may be changed upon due notification.
8. During lunch, all accidents, whether they occur on or off campus will be reported to the School Resource Officer immediately.
9. A student who is referred to the administration for any reason resulting in disciplinary action may have his/her permit revoked by the Principal.
10. A student, who is habitually tardy returning from lunch or does not go through proper procedures to check out, may lose his/her lunch permit for a specified time period.
11. Any student who leaves campus for off-campus lunch must leave in a vehicle with someone authorized to take the student off-campus. Students are not allowed to walk off campus. Any student who walks off-campus will receive disciplinary action and/or revocation of their off-campus lunch pass.
