AXS Companion to Common App

- Keep your college list and admission plan (i.e. Early Action or Regular Decision) up to date in your Common App account so your recommenders can keep up with deadlines for materials.

- Use the Applications Requirement Grid to keep track of deadlines, application fees, recommendations needed, etc.

- Answer the question!
- Be authentic
- Share your personality
- Consider how the question specifically relates to you and make your essay about you
- Brainstorm and take notes first
- For your first draft, just write
- Structure matters
- Be creative, tell your story well
- Be honest
- Proofread and make corrections
 - Try reading the essay out loud to yourself to catch mistakes
- Feedback is essential

"Common App College Essay" = Specific University "Personal Statement" (These both just mean longer written response)

English Class Essays vs. Personal Statements

English Class Essays

- Purpose: To make an argument and support with evidence.
- Thesis is often explicit, and appears in first paragraph.
- Tone: More analytical, often examining a specific text.
- "I" statements: 🔀

Personal Statements

- Purpose: To demonstrate the values. skills, qualities, and interests you'll bring with you to a college campus.
- Thesis is often implied or not stated at all. If one does appear, often at/near end.
- Tone: More casual, personal-you are the "text."
