Green Level High was founded in 2019 and is one of Wake County Public School System's 33 high schools. GLHS is Nationally Recognized for academics, athletics and arts honors and awards. GLHS is an AP 2024 Platinum Honor Roll School. Our students participate in 35 varsity and junior varsity sports; over 100 leadership and service-oriented clubs; and a full range of course offerings including Honors, Advanced Placement and CTE Completers. The Class of 2022 was our first graduating class.

GRADING AND GPA INFORMATION

Transcripts reflect both weighted and unweighted cumulative grade point averages. Class rank is based on the weighted cumulative grade point average. AP courses earn 1.0 extra quality point and Honors courses earn 0.5 extra quality point.
