Green Level High School Early/Mid-Year Graduation Request Form

Requirements

Wake County School Board Policy #5530.2.2

Whenever a student completes graduation requirements early, the student:

- A. May elect to graduate prior to the end of the academic year
- B. May not participate in any extracurricular activities or athletics after mid-year graduation
- C. May participate in graduation practice and ceremony at the principal's discretion if a signed request from the parent/guardian has been received within two weeks of the end of the final semester of study.

Procedures

Procedures for Early/Mid-Year Graduation:

- 1. The parent(s)/court appointed custodian(s) of a student may request early graduation for the student by filing a written request with the school principal at least thirty days prior to the beginning of the student's last semester of enrollment.
- 2. The principal, with a committee of the local school staff, considers the request and approves or denies graduation prior to one's class on an individual case-by-case basis, subject to the criteria stated above.
- 3. All applications must be submitted by June 1st.

<u>Please note</u>: Once a student has decided to graduate early/mid-year, he/she is only allowed to participate in the following school-sponsored activities in the spring semester: graduation rehearsal and the graduation ceremony. Graduates who are invited as a guest of a Green Level HS student may attend prom.

Green Level High School Early/Mid-Year Graduation Request Form

I. Early Graduates: Graduating one year early at the end of the junior year.

Requirements & Procedures

For graduation prior to one's class a student must:

- A. Show satisfactory mastery of high school academic skills and concepts
- B. Show a need for early graduation (graduating before your class)
- C. Meet the graduation course and testing requirements effective the year he/she entered ninth grade for the first time.
- D. Be a student in good standing (no outstanding fees, discipline issues, etc)
- E. The parent(s)/court appointed custodian(s) of the student may request early graduation for the student by filing a written request with the school principal at least thirty (30) days prior to the beginning of the student's last semester of enrollment.
- F. The principal, with a committee of the local school staff, considers the request, rendering a decision to approve/deny the request to graduate prior to one's class on an individual, case-by-case basis, subject to the criteria stated above.
- G. Indicate their desire to participate in the June graduation ceremony at the time of the request.

<u>Note</u>: Once a student has decided to graduate early/mid-year, he/she is only allowed to participate in two school-sponsored activities in the spring semester, graduation rehearsal and the graduation ceremony. Graduates who are invited as a guest of a Green Level HS student may attend prom.

H. Students who plan to complete college admission requirements before their eighth semester in high school are encouraged to meet with their school counselor regarding post-secondary opportunities.

<u>Note</u>: Students applying to college are responsible for contacting colleges/universities prior to completing this form to determine if early or mid-year graduation will affect their admission status.

II. Mid-Year Graduates: Graduating one semester early (January) in the senior year.

Requirements & Procedures

Students who wish to graduate mid-year of their senior year must:

A. Meet the graduation course and testing requirements effective the year he/she entered ninth grade for the first time.

<u>Note</u>: Students applying to college are responsible for contacting colleges/universities prior to completing this form to determine if early or mid-year graduation will affect their admission status.

- B. Complete the Early/Mid-Year Graduation request form no later than October 31st of the fall semester of their senior year indicating their desire to graduate mid-year. The signature of the student and their parent(s)/court appointed custodian(s) <u>must</u> be included on the request form.
- C. Indicate their desire to participate in the June graduation ceremony.

<u>Note</u>: Once a student has decided to graduate mid-year, he/she is only allowed to participate in two school-sponsored activities in the spring semester, graduation rehearsal and the graduation ceremony. Graduates who are invited as a guest of a Green Level HS student may attend prom.

D. Be a student in good standing (no outstanding fees, discipline issues, etc)
