### Directions for Summer Assignments #1 - 5

All summer assignments will be posted via Google Classroom beginning in mid-June. All assignments must be submitted via Google Classroom. Deadlines are TWO WEEKS apart. Each assignment should take 2 – 3 hours to complete. You may submit assignments any time before the deadline. Releasing all assignments in June allows you to work around travel plans or any other commitments. **PLAN AHEAD!!!**

**CALCULATORS AND OTHER MATH AIDS ARE NOT ALLOWED**, unless explicitly stated in the problem. **This means you should not use any programs, apps, or searches to solve the problem.** While there are many tools out there, be sure that you are using them as an aid to get you "unstuck" and not as a replacement for completing your own work. It is permissible to look up a topic but not solve particular problems. Complete all problems in each assignment and **SHOW ALL WORK!** Remember to label axis on any graphs and include units in your answers. Please feel free to seek assistance from friends, parents, peers, siblings, tutors, etc. We do encourage you to collaborate. **However, please note that helpful collaboration might mean to suggest a next step or point out a possible error.** Cheating would include sending a photo of your work or copying someone else's work step by step. Posting questions to Google Classroom is also a good strategy. We will post additional resources for certain assignments. Remember, the work you submit **MUST BE YOUR OWN WORK.**

All work and any additional pages showing work should be submitted on **Google Classroom**.

Option #1: Take a picture(s) and upload image(s) from a mobile device

Option #2: Use a scanner or phone app (like cam scanner) to upload document(s) from your computer

View and make sure all of your documents are uploaded and readable before you click submit.

If possible, please print out the assignments and complete the work on the worksheets. If you cannot print, please complete your assignments on neatly labeled and organized separate sheets of paper. **Please keep all work in a binder. You will be assessed (quiz/test) on this material during the first week of class in August.**

Assignments will be graded for **completion and accuracy**. We will use a 2 point rubric for each question. Details will be posted to Google Classroom. Solutions will be made available no earlier than one week after each deadline so you can review your work and prepare for the assessments during the first week of school. **No assignments will be accepted after solutions are released.**

If you have any issues with assignments, email BOTH TEACHERS to ensure you get a timely response. If you have technical difficulties, DO NOT EMAIL YOUR ASSIGNMENTS directly to us. You can email a link to a Google doc as a temporary measure if you have trouble submitting your images.

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
