Because Band/Strings are yearlong courses, these students are not enrolled into Exploratory Language if they are studying a world language while in middle school. All 6th graders will take an Intent to Study a World Language Survey in the fall of their 6th grade year.</p> <p>***There are a limited number of seats available for beginning world languages in 6th grade. These seats are reserved for students that are in yearlong electives and/or seeking two credits in a world language. All 6th graders will take an Intent to Study a World Language Survey in the fall of their 6th grade year. If exploratory language is scheduled at the time Spanish 1a or French 1a is offered, the student will be dropped from exploratory language and will only be enrolled in the 1a course.</p> <p>***There are a limited number of seats available for beginning a world language in 6th grade. These seats are reserved for students that are in yearlong electives and/or seeking two credits in a world language. All other students begin their language study in 7th grade.</p> <p>Students in Band or Strings must be approved by the principal to attend the 2 Credit program as the course load will impact enrollment into PE*.</p>

One of these classes will be French 1a or Spanish 1a.</p> <p>Semester 2: 1 class on A day & 1 class on B day. 8th Grade	<p>Semester 1: Advanced Band or Advanced Strings and PE*.</p> <p>Semester 2: Advanced Band or Advanced Strings and the third course in their language program: French 1c (MS for HS credit) or Spanish 1c (MS for HS credit). Student takes final exam - 20% of overall grade.</p>	<p>Semester 1: 1 class on A day & 1 class on B day.</p> <p>Semester 2: 1 class on A day & 1 class on B day.</p> <p>Of these four classes, one will be the third course in their language program: French 1c (MS for HS credit) or Spanish 1c (MS for HS credit). Student takes final exam - 20% of overall grade.</p> <p>Of these four classes, one must also be Physical Education*</p>	<p>Semester 1: A and B day: French 2a or Spanish 2a (double block).</p> <p>Semester 2: 1 class on A day and 1 class on B day. Of these two classes, one will be French 2b or Spanish 2b and one will be PE. At the end of 2b students will take a final exam that will be 20% of their overall grade.</p>

Students must pass each level of the language program with a 60 or higher to move forward in the program. Final Exams are required and 20% of the 1c class and 2b class. Students in the 2-credit program must be in strong academic standing and have all As and Bs, 4s and 5s on their Reading and Math EOGs each year, and a World Language teacher's endorsement. 1a, 1b, 1c, and 2a, 2b our what DDMMS calls their courses. In PowerSchool/Homebase these courses are listed as 1a: Beginning less than one year, 1b: Less than one year, 1c: 1 MS for HS Credit 2a: 2 Part I, and 2b: 2 Part II.
