- DUE TO THE VARIETY OF PATHWAYS, WE EXPECT ALL STUDENTS TO GRADUATE HAVING MET AT LEAST 5 OF THE FOLLOWING:
 EARN A 2.5 WEIGHTED GPA (OR HIGHER)
 SCORE AT LEAST A 17 ON THE ACT OR 930 ON THE SAT

 - IVERSITY TRANSFER COURSES & EARN A C OR HIGHER BY END OF 3RD QUARTER SENIOR YEAR
 - EARN AT LEAST 2 CTE CREDENTIALS
 - HAVE NO MORE THAN 10 UNEXCUSED ABSENCES PER SEMESTER DURING JUNIOR & SENIOR YEARS (BEFORE 2ND SEMESTER OF SENIOR YEAR)
 - COMPLETE 40+ COMMUNITY

- STUDENTS WILL EARN A GRADUATION CORD, SENIOR AWARDS RECOGNITION, & A SYMBOL ON GRADUATION PROGRAM
 MOST WILL BE TRACKED BY STUDENT SERVICES, BUT SOME MAY REQUIRE STUDENT SUBMISSIONS



EARN A 2.5 WEIGHTED GPA (OR HIGHER)

- WHAT IS A WEIGHTED GPA?
 - OVERALL ACADEMIC AVERAGE OF A STUDENT FROM FRESHMAN TO SENIOR YEAR
 - USUALLY ON A 0-4.0 CREDIT SCALE, GIVING ADDITIONAL "WEIGHTED" CREDIT TO AP, HONORS, AND COMMUNITY COLLEGE COURSES
- WHAT'S THE RATIONALE?
 - A 2.5 WEIGHTED GPA IS THE MINIMUM UNC SYSTEM REQUIREMENT FOR COLLEGE ADMISSIONS
- WHAT COUNTS?
 - ALL FINAL COURSE GRADES FROM FRESHMAN YEAR TO JANUARY OF SENIOR YEAR.
- ADDITIONAL TAKEAWAYS:

 - STUDENT GPAS WILL BE ASSESSED IN JANUARY OF THEIR SENIOR YEAR FOR THIS.
 GPA IS ACCESSIBLE ON YOUR TRANSCRIPT AFTER 1ST SEMESTER OF FRESHMAN YEAR.





SCORE AT LEAST A 17 ON THE ACT OR 930 ON THE SAT

- WHAT ARE THE ACT AND SAT?
 - COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAMS USED FOR ADMISSIONS AND SCHOLARSHIPS
- WHAT'S THE RATIONALE?
 - A 17 ON THE ACT OR 930 ON THE SAT IS THE MINIMUM UNC SYSTEM REQUIREMENT FOR COLLEGE ADMISSIONS.
- ADDITIONAL TAKEAWAYS:
 - ALL STUDENTS TAKE THE ACT ON CAMPUS AT VMCCA THEIR JUNIOR YEAR.
 - STUDENTS CAN RETAKE THESE EXAMS SEVERAL TIMES TO GET A "SUPERSCORE," WHICH IS THE COMPOSITE SCORE OF A STUDENT'S HIGHEST SECTION SCORES FROM MULTIPLE TEST DATES.
 - VMCCA HAS AN ACT BOOTCAMP IN THE SPRING TO HELP STUDENTS PREPARE.

SCORE A 3 OR HIGHER ON AT LEAST 3 EOCS

- WHAT IS AN EOC?
 - END OF COURSE EXAMS CREATED BY THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA
 - ONLY GIVEN IN BIOLOGY, ENGLISH 2, MATH 1, AND MATH 3
- **WHAT'S THE RATIONALE?**
 - SCORING A 3 (OR HIGHER) INDICATES A STUDENT IS PROFICIENT IN THE SUBJECT



- **ADDITIONAL NOTES:**
 - STUDENTS CAN ONLY TAKE THESE EXAMS ONCE.
 - SCORES TRANSFER WITH THE STUDENTS, MEANING:

 - IF A FRESHMAN TOOK MATH 1 IN MIDDLE SCHOOL AND SCORED A 3 OR HIGHER, THIS COUNTS
 IF A STUDENT TRANSFERRED IN AS A SOPHOMORE OR JUNIOR AND SCORED A 3 OR HIGHER ON PAST EOCS, THESE ALSO COUNT



EARN 2 OR MORE HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS IN WORLD LANGUAGE

- WHAT'S THE RATIONALE?
 - 2 CREDITS ARE REQUIRED FOR MANY 4-YEAR UNIVERSITIES
- WHAT COURSES COUNT?
 - ANY WORLD LANGUAGES, INCLUDING AP COURSES AND THOSE TAKEN IN MIDDLE SCHOOL FOR HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT
- ADDITIONAL NOTES:
 - VMCCA OFFERS SEVERAL SPANISH AND SPANISH HERITAGE COURSES.





SCORE SILVER OR HIGHER ON THE ACT WORKKEYS EXAM

- WHAT'S THE ACT WORKKEYS EXAM?
 - A CAREER-READINESS TEST TAKEN BY SENIORS THAT ASSESS THEIR WORKPLACE SKILLS
- **WHAT'S THE RATIONALE?**
 - IT'S RECOGNIZED BY EMPLOYERS ACROSS MANY INDUSTRIES
- **ADDITIONAL NOTES:**

 - SCORE OPTIONS ARE BRONZE, SILVER, GOLD, OR PLATINUM
 COMPRISED OF THREE CORE ASSESSMENTS: APPLIED MATH, GRAPHIC LITERACY, & **WORKPLACE DOCUMENTS**





TAKE 3+ COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY TRANSFER COURSES & EARN A C OR HIGHER BY END OF 3RD QUARTER OF SENIOR YEAR
