Per ESSA Section 1111(d)(2), schools are identified as TSI-AT schools in North Carolina because one or more of the following subgroups received a subgroup performance grade score at or below the highest identified CSI-LP school's All Students group during the identification year; and is on the TSI-CU list for the subgroup(s) for the previous year. Subgroup performance scores are provided for the following subgroups: (1) Students with Disabilities, (2) Economically Disadvantaged, (3) Black, (4) White, (5) Hispanic, (6) Asian-Pacific Islander, (7) Multi-racial, and (8) English Learners. This letter is to notify our parents and guardians of Conn Magnet Elementary's intentions to improve educational outcomes for underperforming student subgroups and close achievement gaps for all students.

We have set the following goals for Conn Magnet Elementary this year:

- By June 2024, Conn Magnet Elementary will meet or exceed growth measured by our EVAAS Overall College and Career Readiness data.
  - o In reading, our expected long-term goal is from 44.1% to 61.6%.
  - In math, our expected long-term goal is from 62.3% to 72%.

Here are some strategies that we will be implementing to improve student outcomes:

- Standards-aligned units of instruction for each subject and grade level
- Data-driven conversations to identity students in need of instructional support or enrichment
- Enhanced social and emotional lessons in all classrooms
- A tiered instructional system that allows teachers to deliver evidence-based instruction aligned with the individual needs of students

Also, parent engagement is at the heart of our school improvement efforts. Here are some ways we can work together:

- Make sure that both you and your student are aware of academic expectations set for your student this school year.
