- Community Colleges across NC offer tuition-free college classes to high school students who qualify
- Students sign up through Wake Tech or any other Community College across NC
- Two class tracks:
 - **College Transfer** – for students planning to pursue a four-year degree
 - **Career and Technical (CTE)**– for students planning to pursue a two-year degree or certificate.
- Some of the CTE classes taken in high school offer college credit to students enrolled at Wake Tech

WORK-BASED LEARNING

Internships

- Juniors/Seniors who are serious about a specific career, and meet the criteria (class prerequisites and grades) may qualify for a high school internship as a class at GHHS
- Students apply through Mr. Katsuleris the semester before the internship
- Involves 120 contact hours on-site and assignments to Mr. Katsuleris
- Students locate the host company

- **Several military options:**

- **Military Academies** – elite colleges that prepare students for military leadership.
- **Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC)**, offered at over 1700 college campuses across the U.S. – ROTC prepares young adults to become officers in the U.S. Military, in exchange for college scholarship money.
- **Enlistment** - Students may enlist after high school. Military recruiters visit during lunch.
- Military benefits include training, college funding, benefits and career development.
