

- Community Colleges across NC offer tuition-free college classes to high school students who qualify
- Students sign up through Wake Tech or any other Community College across NC
- Two class tracks:
 - College Transfer for students planning to pursue a four-year degree
 - Career and Technical (CTE)— for students planning to pursue a two-year degree or certificate.
- Some of the CTE classes taken in high school offer college credit to students enrolled at Wake Tech

WORK-BASED LEARNING

Internships

- Juniors/Seniors who are serious about a specific career, and meet the criteria (class prerequisites and grades) may qualify for a high school internship as a class at GHHS
