Wake County EMS is offering an internship over the summer for selected high school juniors and seniors during the months of June, July, and August of 2025.

This internship is aligned to the WCPSS internship standards for hours and obligations. The program will span over the summer months providing a wide variety of opportunities and content. Students will be emersed in our academy, simulations, field trips, specialty classes, and ambulance observation shifts. Students will be exposed to the different departments that make our EMS system function each day. The final project will reflect upon the experiences during the internship and will be presented. Upon successful completion of this internship, students will have 120 hours and maybe eligible for one (1) credit hour at participating high schools.
