

## FALL - SPRING PAID & HYBRID/REMOTE INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Ready, Set, App! (Sponsored by Lenovo) is looking for high school interns possessing

- Computer Science Technical Skills and Interpersonal Skills
- A Passion for Computer Science



## As an intern, you will:

- 1. Be assigned as mentors to the teams competing in the Ready! Set! App! Competition.
- 2. Provide insight and guidance to students as they develop their apps.
- 3. Meet with teams on a regular basis to track progress and answer questions, helping them overcome any obstacles on their pathway to success. (This help includes things such as tips on time management, troubleshooting code, providing insight on designs, and more. They're a vital resource to this competition and we need hardworking, dedicated students to fill these spots.)
- 4. Intern **10 hours a week**. This includes regular meetings with student teams, RSA leadership, marketing/outreach for the competition, and other tasks included in organizing this event.
- 5. Begin in November 2024 and end in April 2025.
- 6. Have multiple opportunities for professional development, helping students grow into capable, young professionals.

Who May Apply: Students enrolled in grades 9-12 in a North Carolina high school.

What Experience Must I Have? There is no set experience requirement for this internship. Students don't need to be an expert in computer science, but some experience with coding or app design is necessary.

Where Do I Work? This internship is hybrid, with most of the work being remote (working at home). There are a few in-person events that interns will be required to attend. Those dates will be provided to the interns well in advance of the event, and travel costs are reimbursed.

What is the Application Deadline? Monday, October 21, 2024 by 11:59 PM. Applicants who make it to the second round will be contacted for virtual interviews in the weeks following the end of the application period.

**Is This a Paid Internship?** Yes. It's a great opportunity for students to get real work and leadership experience. We encourage all interested students to apply.

How Long Will I Intern? The internship will run through both the Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 semesters.
