Dear Student,

The Millbrook High School Ambassador Program gives students the opportunity to positively promote Millbrook High School, while developing leadership skills through interacting with new students and families, school staff and faculty, and the local community. Student Ambassadors will be visible at campus events (tours and open houses) and will provide leadership for Millbrook High School. Students selected for the Millbrook Ambassadors will receive training in the areas of communication, leadership, public relations, and school history. Upon submitting an application, candidates will be interviewed by the MHS Ambassador committee.

To be considered for the Millbrook Ambassadors, students must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Sophomore or Junior
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Hold a Good Attendance Record (No More than 2 Absences per Quarter)
- Be actively involved in at least one school activity (athletics, arts, clubs, etc)
- Complete the online application at <https://forms.gle/VdyCmkrABbqMzgc68> by **Wednesday, October 11th** (you MUST be logged in to your WCPSS account to access the application) in its entirety.
- Complete the **Teacher Recommendation Form (3 recommendations)** and the video release and submit them to the online application

Expectations of Ambassadors will include all of the following:

- Attend an Ambassador Training Session on Thursday, October 22nd from 2:35-3:10 until in room 3508
- Participate in a certain number of tours during the school day by answering questions, sharing experiences, and other applicable activities- from October to May
- Participate in all of the following on-campus events:
 - IB Expo- Tuesday, November 7- from 5:45-8:00
 - Magnet Open House- Thursday, January 14- from 5:45- 8:00
 - New Magnet Family Meet and Greet- Wednesday, April 29- from 5:30- 8:00
- Participate in one off-campus event:
 - WCPSS Magnet Fair @ Enloe High School- Saturday October 26th-9:00am-12:00pm

As school leaders, Millbrook Ambassadors must remain in good standing to remain in the program (academics, behavior, attendance). Expectations and tentative activities are subject to modification by our IB Coordinators and administration based upon the needs of Millbrook High School.
