- CADY will not return to campus after this date.**

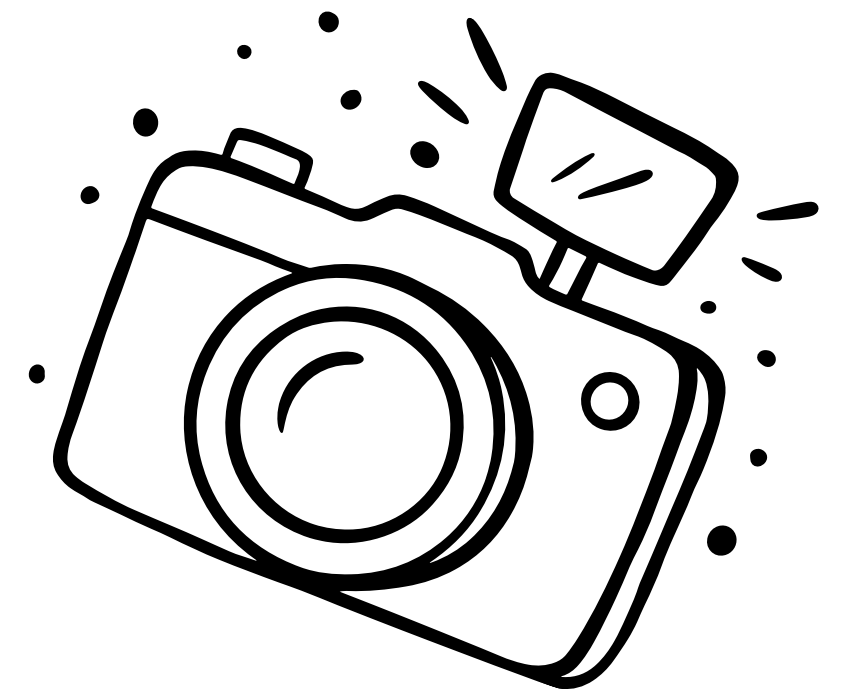

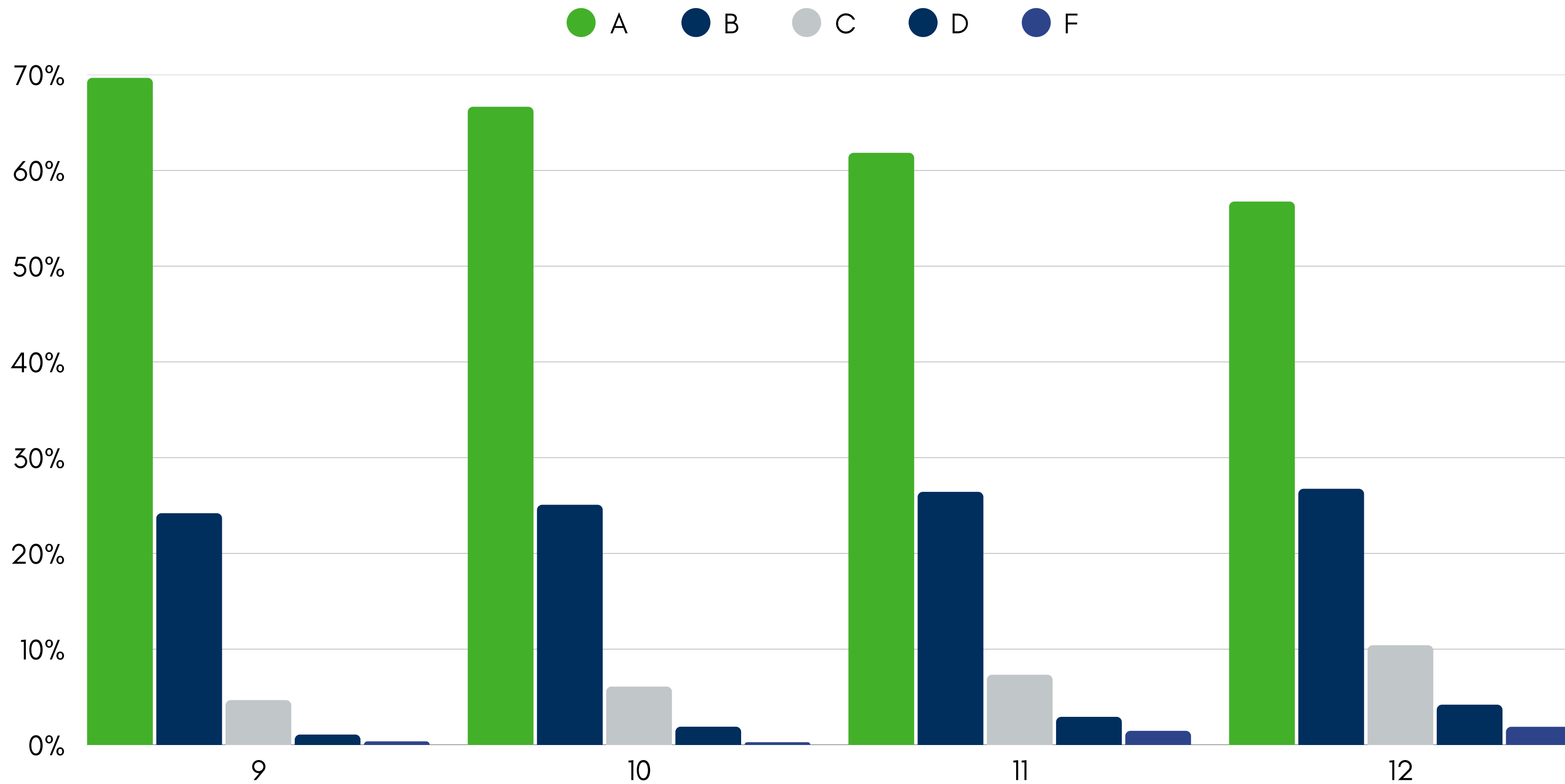

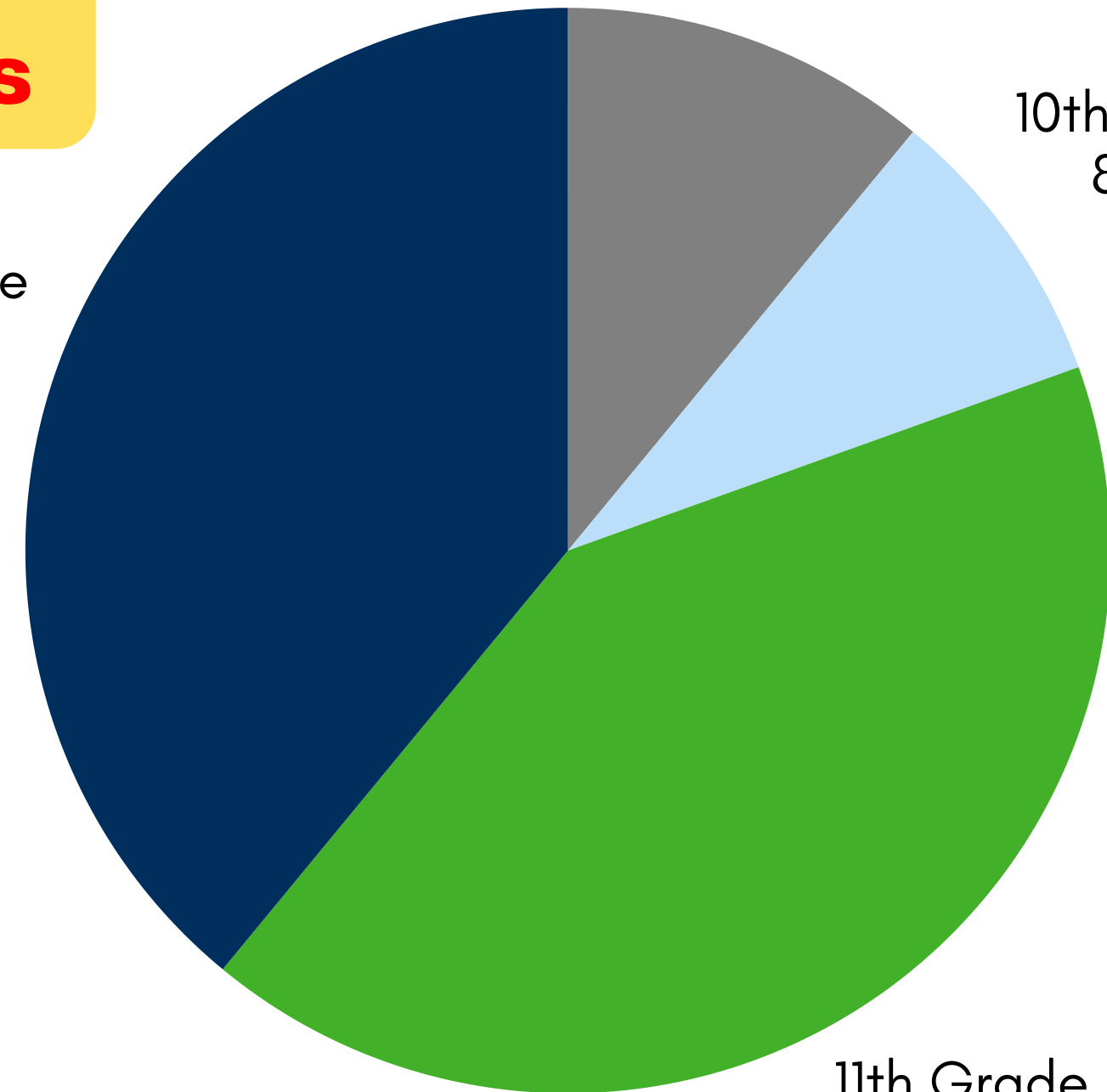

Off-Campus Lunch Passes

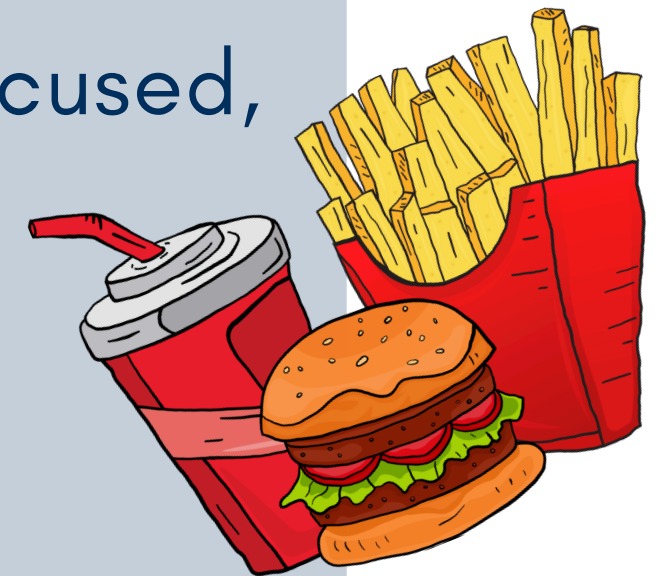


OFF-CAMPUS LUNCH PASS

Students with an off-campus lunch pass must remain in good standing, or risk having their lunch pass revoked.

"Good Standing" means:

- having 10 or fewer absences (excused, unexcused, and educational leave) in any class
- having 10 or fewer tardies (excused and unexcused) in any class
- and passing,
 - Q1, Q2 and Q3: 3 out of 4 classes
 - Q4: all classes as of 5/18/26

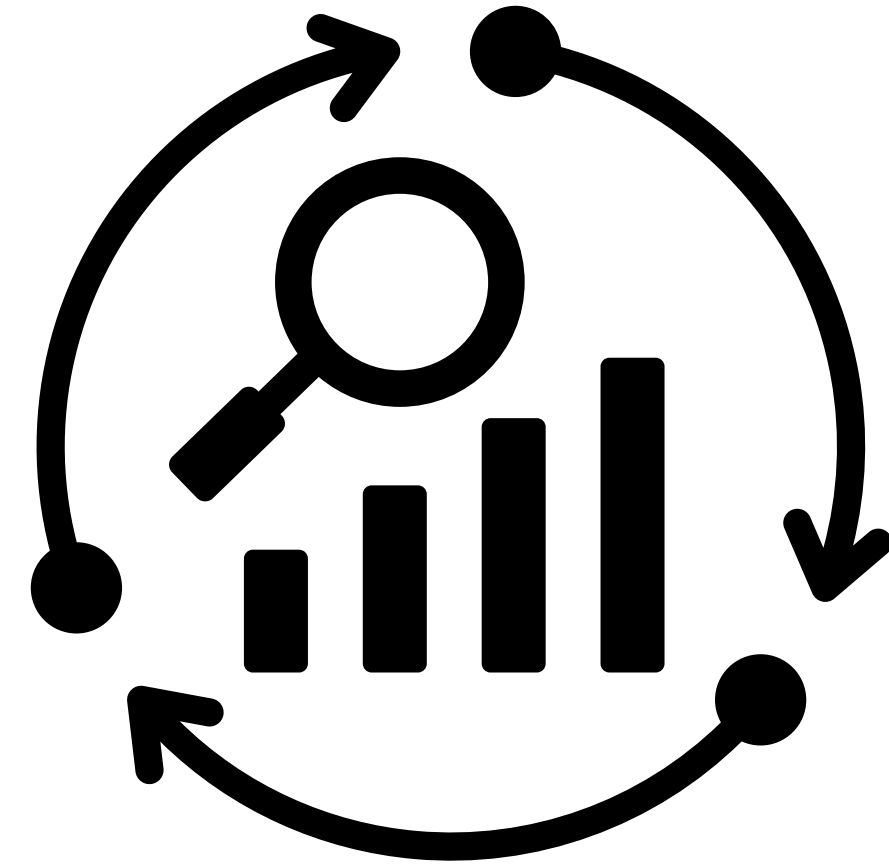
Lunch Pass Data

All WCPSS high schools have agreed that students in Grade 12 may be exempt from exams based on the following criteria:



- Students must have a projected final grade of B or higher **AND** have 10 or fewer absences (including excused, unexcused and educational leave) in the course
- Students cannot be exempt from state testing including field testing.
- Waivers are NOT available

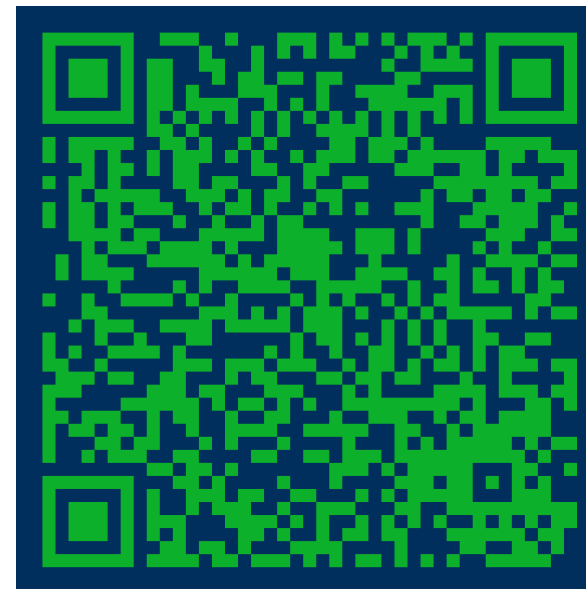
