

- · CADY will not return to campus after this date.


Mrs. Weeks (eweeks@wcpss.net) will email any Seniors who still need to have their picture taken with their appointment details.







Off-Campus Lunch Passes

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OFF-CAMPUS LUNCH PASS

Students with an off-campus lunch pass must remain in good standing, or risk having their lunch pass revoked.

"Good Standing" means:

 having 10 or fewer absences (excused, unexcused, and educational leave) in any class

 having 10 or fewer tardies (excused and unexcused) in any class

Senior Exam Exemptions



All WCPSS high schools have agreed that students in Grade 12 may be exempt from exams based on the following criteria:



- Students must have a projected final grade of B or higher <u>AND</u> have 10 or fewer absences (including excused, unexcused and educational leave) in the course
- Students cannot be exempt from state testing including field testing.
- Waivers are NOT available






