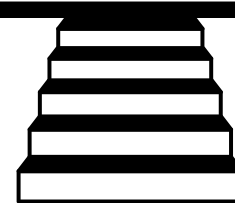



Final Transcript Request through ScribOnline



ScribOnline routes your transcript to school based on your exit survey



College receives transcript and then pairs it with your application

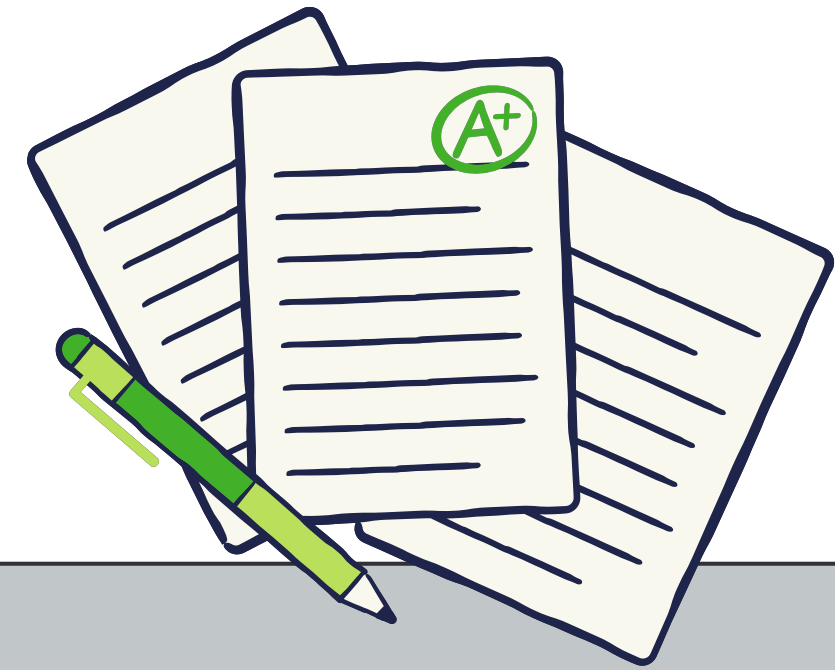


Exam Exemption Notification (6/2)



Students who are exempt from their exams will be notified by their teachers

All WCPSS high schools have agreed that students in Grade 12 may be exempt from exams based on the following criteria:



Students must have:

- a projected final grade of B or higher AND
- 10 or fewer absences (including excused, unexcused and educational leave) in the course.



Reminder: Students cannot be exempted from any state exams or field tests
