What we're learning

Math

Students will work on adding and subtracting decimal numbers using models and standard algorithm. Students will also work on adding and subtracting fractions with different demoninators using models.

Literacy

Students read informational texts about Jackie Robinson to explore the factors that contributed to his success and how interactions between people and events shaped his impact. They also examine how athletes can create social change. Skills practiced include identifying main ideas, summarizing, and comparing and contrasting.

Science

Students learn about daily and seasonal weather, how it is different from climate, and what affects it, such as temperature, wind, and precipitation. They use tools and data to track weather and find patterns over time. Students also compare weather and climate in different places around the world.
