SCIENCE/SOCIAL STUDIES

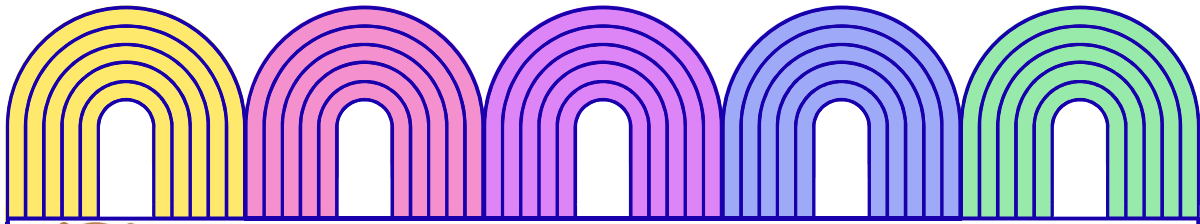
In Science we will learn about fossils found on and under the Earth's surface, Environmental Changes and Adaptations, and Human Impact to the Environment.
