We're excited to share what your child will be learning this quarter! November is full of growth, discovery, and hands-on learning across all subjects.

Literacy

Students will build vocabulary, read with fluency, and deepen their comprehension by referring to the text. They'll write organized informative and narrative pieces using descriptive details, dialogue, and proper grammar. During All Block, students will read independently, collaborate with peers, and practice fluency and self-correction strategies. These lessons help strengthen reading, writing, and communication skills.

+ Math

This quarter, students will:

- Use place value and properties of operations to solve multi-digit arithmetic problems.
- Practice solving real-world problems using all four operations.
- Understand the relationship between multiplication and division.
- Multiply and divide within 100.
- Explore and reason with shapes and their attributes.

Encourage your child to practice math facts at home to build fluency!

Science

Our focus is on Forces and Motion!

Students will learn that changes in speed or direction are caused by pushes and pulls (forces). They'll explore how motion changes depending on the amount of force and predict how different strengths of pushes or pulls affect an object's movement. Students will also study how speed affects the time it takes an object to travel a distance—hands-on experiments make this an exciting unit!
