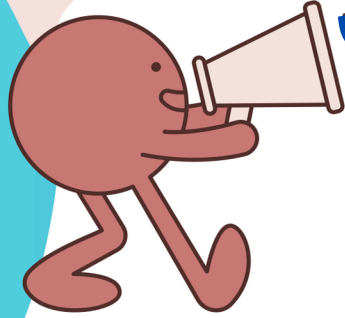
IN SPANISH...

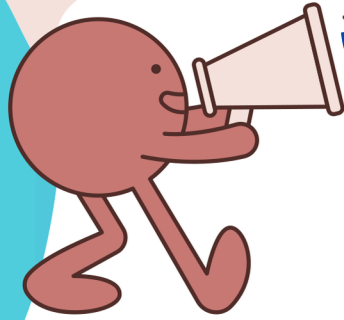

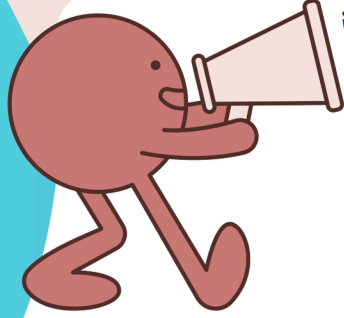

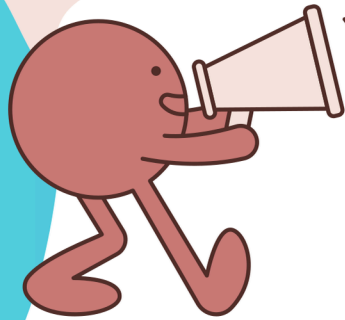
