For students who made lower than a B in 8th grade Math or a D or lower in Math I in the 8th grade. (2 courses)

#### Math I Honors For students who maintained high B's or A's in 7th and 8th grade Math. (1 course)

#### Math 2

- Math Plus Honors (fall) and Math 2 Honors (spring)
  For students who made a low B or below in Math I in middle school. (2 courses)

For students who successfully passed Math 2 in middle school. (1 course)
