### Important Notes

- All students are required to take North Carolina End-of-Course (EOC) and North Carolina CTE Post-Assessments on campus. A list of those exams can be found below.
- Students must bring their CHARGED WCPSS-issued device to use for all exams.
- **Grading for Exams:** EOCs, CTE Post-Assessments, and teacher-made exams will count 20% of the final course grade and are **REQUIRED of ALL** students. A **Zero** will be recorded for an exam grade if the student does not take the exam within the 10 day window. The original EOC scale score, achievement level, and percentile will be reflected on the student transcript.
- **Testing Outside of the Exam Window:** Students cannot test outside of the 2026 testing window of May 29- June 11. Exceptions must be requested and approved in advance by the district, but these are only ever granted for true emergencies. Travel in or out of the country is **NOT** a qualifying reason to request testing outside of the prescribed window. The district only approves exceptions in very rare cases. To submit a request to test outside the exam window, complete this [Google Form](#). Requests must be submitted **no later than Thursday, April 30, 2026**, to be considered.
- **AP Exams:** Students enrolled in an AP course may choose to opt out of taking the AP exam, but will still be required to take a teacher-made final exam or complete a final project. If students want to improve their grade, the student may opt in to take/complete the teacher-made exam or project. The teacher-made exam or project will be administered/completed on the designated teacher-made class testing day. Students, whether they opt out of the AP Exam or not, may be exempt from the teacher-made final exam/project if they meet the Final Exam exemption criteria.
- **Medical Exemptions:** Students with significant medical or health concerns should contact their counselor to complete a medical exemption waiver. **Medical waivers are also due no later than May 1, 2026.** Students are required to take a state-required EOC, CTE, and/or teacher-made exam unless a medical exemption has been approved by the district office.
- **Senior Final Exams & Exemptions:** Seniors who have a **final grade of a “B” or better** in a course and no more than **10** class absences will be considered **EXEMPT** from the teacher-made final exam for that course. Per district policy, absences include excused and unexcused absences, as well as college visits or educational leave absences.
  - *Dr. Saunders will only accept a medical waiver of absences over 10 for the most extreme of medical emergencies that occurred this year; ones that led to multiple days in a row of the Senior being out of school. Those medical-emergency absence waiver requests must be submitted on this [google form](#) to Dr. Saunders no later than **April 30th**.*
  - Senior teacher-made project/exams will be **completed during the teacher made testing dates. (see dates above)**
  - If a Senior qualifies for a WCPSS exam exemption, teachers will use the exempt symbol in Infinite Campus for any **Senior that is exempt May 19th, A Day and May 20th, B Day**. Senior attendance will be taken up to the exemption notification date. Seniors **cannot** be exempted from CTE Post-Assessment Exams or EOC exams.
- **Underclassmen & Exemptions:** Ninth (9th) - Eleventh (11th) who have a **final grade of a “B” or better** in a course and no more than **10** class absences and **10** tardies will be considered **EXEMPT** from the teacher-made final exam for that course. Underclassmen who have taken an AP or IB exam are exempt for a teacher-made final exam in that course, however, they can opt in to take a final exam to improve their grade. Per district policy, absences include excused and unexcused absences, as well as college visits or educational leave absences. Students will be informed of their exemption status on May 20th B-Day and May 21st A-Day. Underclassmen’s attendance will be taken up to the exemption notification date.
  - It is an expectation that students take exams or present their project during the scheduled day & times. Students must be present at the beginning of the exam period and must remain in the testing location for the duration of the exam to receive credit for the exam. **To maintain the integrity of all exams, students will not be permitted to check-out early during any exam period.** Teachers **MAY NOT** administer teacher made exams or require project exam submission prior to the teacher made testing date for their class period.

## 2026 Exam Guidance for Students and Parents

- Students can leave campus **after the exam session** has been fully concluded by the Test Administrator, if they have completed their google permission form and if they have a way home. Students who remain on campus after exams are complete, must remain in the designated and supervised area until dismissal at 2:20pm, for a study hall.
- Students who are absent from EOCs, CTE Post-Assessments, and teacher-made exams will be contacted by their teacher with a location and time. The student should make-up the exam on June 3rd through June 8th during their respective class period, with state exams taking precedence over teacher made exams.
- According to North Carolina Testing Policy, students are not allowed to bring electronic devices other than approved calculators and **WCPSS supported devices** into the testing room at any time during state testing, including breaks. Any student with a cell phone/electronic device during the testing period may be dismissed from testing, and a misadministration may be declared for that student and, potentially, for the entire room of students. A student who has been dismissed for a violation of the electronic device policy must take the missed exam on a make-up day. Per Wake County School Board Policy 3225, the student is subject to disciplinary action by school administration.
- All buses will depart at 12:10 pm.
- Breakfast and bag lunch will be available for students who must be on campus to take exams.
