

Driver's Ed Classroom: (March 25th Update)

Summer Registration information:

- **Online Registration** for Summer classes will open at Leesville Road High on, **Wednesday, April 9, 2025 at 10am.** Classes will fill quickly. There is no waiting list. Registration is online only.
- **Leesville Road High Summer Schedule will be as follows:**
 - **Session 1: June 23-27, 2025; Times: 7:00 am – 1:00 pm**
 - **Session 2: July 7-11, 2025; Times: 7:00 am – 1:00 pm**
 - **Session 3: July 28-August 1, 2025; Times: 7:00 am – 1:00 pm**
 - **Session 4: August 4-8, 2025; Times: 8 am – 2 pm**
- All classes are in-person and will be held in room 152.

How to register: *Registration for Driver's Ed is available for all Leesville Road High students that are above 14.5 years of age as of the first day of class. All registration must be done and paid for [online](#) during the registration window. Paper forms will not be accepted. Registration is first come first served. No preference is given based on age. Seats fill quickly. There are no waiting lists. **Students can only attend driver's ed classes at their base school.***

*Please note that Driver's Education is a two part course, classroom and behind-the-wheel driving instruction. Expect a **6 month** waiting period between taking the class and getting behind-the-wheel. Please recognize that this is a long process.*

Behind-the-Wheel (BTW): (March 25th update)

- Drivers are contacting the students who took the **October class of 2024** currently. Instructors will call parents by phone to schedule driving. *If you screen your calls, please realize that you might miss a call.*
- The October class will start scheduling in April. **Students can expect a 6 month wait between class ending and being contacted for behind-the-wheel instruction.**
- *Each student has 6 hours of BTW time and 6 hours of observation since there are 2 students in the car.*
- *****If your student has turned 18, s/he must have an adult learners' permit from DMV.**

BTW **must be scheduled with the parent/guardian.**

Please speak to your driver via phone call; students cannot make arrangements themselves. Drivers meet students at LRHS and must return students to LRHS for parent pick-up.

- Once BTW concludes, the driver will issue a **Certificate of Completion**. Please review it carefully **BEFORE** you leave the lesson. If you lose it, refer to this link to request a \$25.00 replacement copy from JDS: [Lost Driver Education Certificate](#)
- **DMV Eligibility Certificates** (DECs) are issued through student services and can be picked up by the student or/parent. You will need to show your copy of the certificate of completion. **You must have the DEC for your DMV visit.**
- Students must remain in good academic standing; **DMV will issue a revocation** as outlined below from page 14 DMV handbook:
DMV must revoke the driver license of any person under age 18 when it receives notice from the proper school authority that the person is no longer eligible for a Driving Eligibility Certificate. This revocation remains in effect until the person's 18th birthday unless a Driving Eligibility Certificate, high school diploma or GED Certificate is obtained.
- Wear appropriate clothing and shoes for BTW – no sandals, flip-flops, etc.
