***Spaces are limited, so please register for only one class. Students must be able to attend all 10 days of the program from 2:30–5:30 PM each day.**

- **Registration Guidelines**

- Registration is **ONLINE ONLY** and available on a **first come, first served** basis. DES has added a step in the registration process for security purposes. When parents/students go to register, they will now be required to do a 2-step authentication by verifying their email before their registration is complete. The registration site will tell the person registering that they must complete this step.
- Classes typically fill up in **under 5 minutes**.
- Students must be **at least 14 ½ years old** on or before the first day of class.
- Each class is capped at **35 students**.
- **No paper forms** or in-person signups are accepted.
- Students may **only register at their base school** (Leesville Road High students must register for the Leesville Road High class).
- **No waiting list** is maintained. If a seat becomes available, it will be shown online for anyone to claim.
- Please keep checking www.jordandriving.com regularly for openings and updates.

Important Notes About the Driver's Ed Program

- **Driver's Education has TWO parts:**
 - 1. **Classroom instruction** (30 hours, must be completed first)
 2. **Behind-the-Wheel (BTW) driving instruction** (6 hours driving + 6 hours observation)

Due to the high number of students, there is often a **3-4 month wait** between the classroom portion and the driving portion.

• Behind-the-Wheel (BTW) Driving Update

- Driving instructors are currently scheduling lessons for students who took the **October 2025** class.
- Students from **November** will drive in **January and February**.
- Students from **December** will most likely drive in **March and April**.

How Driving is Scheduled:

- The driving instructor will call **the parent or guardian** to schedule driving sessions. (They **will not call the student** directly.)
- If you screen calls or use call blocking, you may miss your scheduling opportunity.
- All drives start and end at **Leesville Road High School**.
- BTW instruction includes:
 - **6 hours of driving**
 - **6 hours of in-car observation** (2 students per car)
- **If Your Student is 18 or Older:**
 - They **must have an Adult Learner's Permit** from the DMV **before they can drive** with an instructor.

Certificate of Completion

- Students receive their Driver's Ed Certificate **after finishing the driving portion from the driving instructor**.
- **Please check it for accuracy before leaving your final session** with your driving instructor.

Additional Information & Reminders

DMV Eligibility Certificates (DEC)

- DECs are issued through Student Services at Leesville Road High. A parent or student may pick it up.
- You must bring your Driver's Ed Certificate of Completion when requesting the DEC from Student Services. You must have the DEC for your DMV appointment.

Academic Standing Requirement

As stated in the NC DMV Handbook (Page 14): *DMV must revoke the driver license of any person under age 18 when it receives notice from the proper school authority that the person is no longer eligible for a Driving Eligibility Certificate. This revocation remains in effect until the person's 18th birthday unless a Driving Eligibility Certificate, high school diploma or GED Certificate is obtained*

Driving Attire Reminder

- Wear appropriate shoes and clothing for driving.
- No sandals, slides, crocs, or flip-flops are allowed during BTW sessions.
- **Private Behind-the-Wheel Instruction**
 - If you choose to use a private driving school, it must be self-funded.
