All items are optional for 11th and 12th grade students and family members.

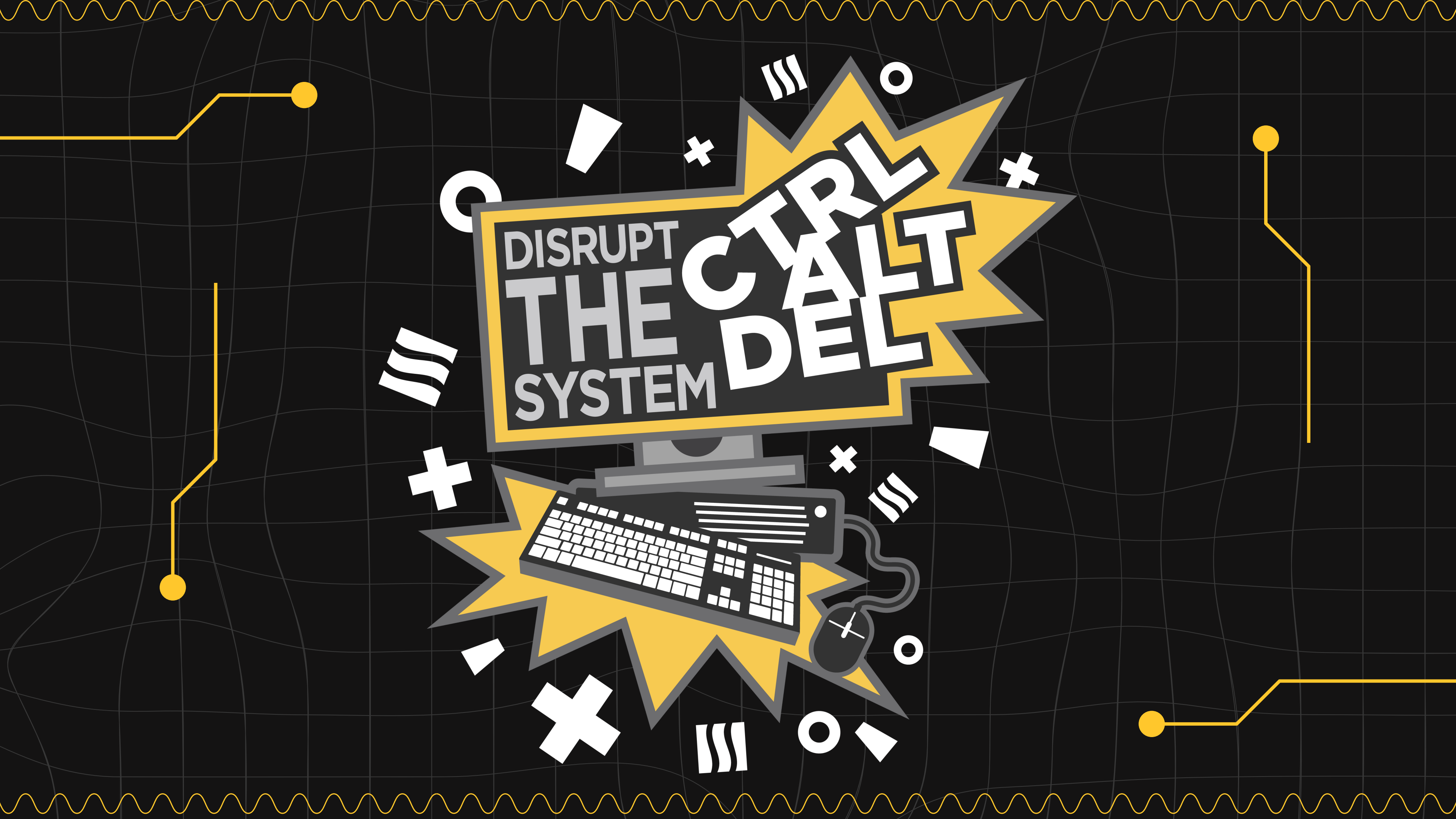
Academy of Information Technology

The Academy of Information Technology (AOIT) is a small learning community within Apex High School. Designed as a four-year high school program, AOIT has an open and equitable student recruitment process that results in a student body that reflects the demographics of the school community. However, students must be assigned to Apex High School to apply. Once accepted into the program, students remain together throughout their high school years with a core group of specially trained teachers. The Academy model provides an environment for these teachers to develop interdisciplinary projects that make learning relevant
