- AND 10 or less cumulative tardies for the semester (total for ALL classes)



To earn it, students must pass a civics test by correctly answering at least 6 out of 10 questions selected from the publicly available questions used for the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services naturalisation test. Seniors, if you are interested in earning an NCDPI Citizenship Proficiency Endorsement on your high school diploma, go to Mobile 6 at the start of lunch on Friday, December 12, to take a 10-question oral citizenship exam.
