(Non state required final exams)

### YOU ARE EXEMPT FROM THE FINAL IF

- You have an A or a B in the class
- AND 10 or less absences in the class
- AND 10 or less cumulative tardies for the semester (total for ALL classes)



# YOU MUST TAKE THE FINAL IF

- You do not have an A or a B in the class
- OR you have 11 or more absences in the class
- <u>OR</u> you have 11 or more cumulative tardies for the semester (total for ALL classes)
